

## SCoRH New Membership Giveaway Terms and Conditions

### Competition

1. The Spinal Research Institute (ABN 11 612 207 169) (“**SRI**”) is conducting a competition called “New Membership Giveaway” (“**Competition**”).
2. These terms and conditions apply to the Competition and by submitting your entry you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. Any entry that does not comply with these terms and conditions may be deemed invalid and ineligible to win a prize.
3. The Competition is open until AEST 23:59, 31 May 2021 (“**Competition End Time**”). Any entry received after the Competition End Time will be deemed invalid. The SRI reserves the right to extend the Competition End Time in its sole discretion.

### Entry

4. SRI employees, contractors and Directors are not eligible to enter.
5. The requirements of entry are as follows:
  - i. Entrants must sign-up as a registered member of the Spinal Cord Research Hub (“**New Entrants**”) by entering their details including name, email address, organisation and referrer (if applicable) at [www.scorh.org/#/signup](http://www.scorh.org/#/signup), then clicking on the link sent to their email address to complete the sign-up process.
  - ii. If a registered member of the Spinal Cord Research Hub tells another person about the Spinal Cord Research Hub (“**Referrer**”) and that person enters the Competition according to the instructions in 5i, including the name of the Referrer, the Referrer will receive an entry to the Competition.
6. Entry into the Competition is free.
7. New Entrants will receive one entry to the Competition.
8. Referrers will receive one entry to the Competition for each New Entrant who lists them as Referrer.

### Judging and Prizes

9. The SRI will judge all valid entries received by the Competition End Time and select a winner at random (“**Prize Winner**”). This Competition is a game of chance and skill plays no part in determining the Prize Winner.
10. The SRI will select one (1) entrant to win a prize.
11. The prize will consist of an ‘upgrade’ registration for the online short course ‘Research Impact: Making a Difference’ from the University of Glasgow and delivered on the learning platform futurelearn.com. The ‘upgrade’ registration provides access to the course for as long as it is on FutureLearn, and a print and digital Certificate of Achievement when eligible.
12. The prize is valued at AUD \$99. The prize cannot be redeemed for cash.
13. The prize draw will take place on 1 June 2021.
14. The Prize Winner will be notified on 1 June 2021 by email. The Prize Winner may also be published in the SRI’s SCoRH Update quarterly newsletter.
15. The decision of the SRI regarding the Prize Winner is final and will be binding on each entrant. No correspondence or communication will be entered into.
16. The SRI will use reasonable endeavours to notify the Prize Winner within 30 days of the prize draw. If after this time the Prize Winner cannot be contacted, cannot accept a prize or is deemed to be ineligible to enter the Competition, the SRI reserves the right to select a different Prize Winner.
17. If any event prevents or hinders the Competition or the SRI’s ability to deliver a prize, the SRI may in its absolute discretion cancel the Competition, select another Prize Winner or provide a similar prize of equivalent value.

18. Each entrant consents to the SRI using any personal information supplied or connected with their entry for the purposes of the Competition and for the SRI’s marketing and promotional purposes.
